

WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND RELEASE FOR USAGE OF U.S. NAVY PROPERTY
(MINOR CHILD)

I, [print adult's name] _____, hereby certify that I am the adult parent or legal guardian of [print child's name] _____, a minor child under the age of eighteen years. On behalf of myself, my child named above, any other heirs or assigns I may have, and next of kin, I HEREBY WAIVE AND RELEASE, indemnify, hold harmless, and forever discharge the UNITED STATES NAVY, the United States Navy's subsidiary entities and commands, agents, employees, officers, directors, affiliates, successors, managers, and assigns, (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the U.S. Navy") of and from any and all claims, demands, debts, contracts, expenses, causes of action, lawsuits, damages, and liabilities of every kind and nature, whether known or unknown, in law or equity, that I ever had or may have, arising from or in any way related to my child's participation in any of the events or activities conducted by the U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps (hereinafter, "Sea Cadets") at Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek-Fort Story, including at Explosive Ordnance Disposal Group TWO, to include the Fast Rope & Rappelling Tower evolution, between June 28, 2025 and July 8, 2025.

I understand that the property on which this activity will take place belongs to the U.S. Navy, but the U.S. Navy makes no warranties or representations either to the Sea Cadets or to you regarding the safety or suitability of the property for the Sea Cadets' activities. It is the sole responsibility of Sea Cadets personnel to inspect the property, evaluate it in relation to the proposed activities, and take any necessary precautions to ensure the safety of your child. I understand that the activities my child will be participating in on U.S. Navy property may involve the risk of injuries, including serious physical injury and damage to personal property.

I understand that the U.S. Navy and the Sea Cadets are separate organizations—the Sea Cadets are not a subsidiary organization of the U.S. Navy. I understand U.S. Navy personnel will provide no supervision of your child or any other participants during this activity, and that the U.S. Navy makes no warranties or representations as to the qualifications or competence of the Sea Cadets personnel or volunteers assigned to supervise your child on behalf of the Sea Cadets.

Knowing the risks described above, I agree, personally, and on behalf of the minor child named above, to assume all the risks and responsibilities surrounding my minor child's involvement in this Sea Cadets event. To the fullest extent allowed by law, I hold harmless and agree to indemnify the U.S. Navy and all entities collectively referred to above, from and against any present or future claim, cause of action, loss or liability for injury to person or property, which said minor child may suffer or for which said minor child may be liable to any other person, related to said minor child's participation in this event, resulting from any cause whatsoever, and regardless of fault. I understand that the U.S. Navy shall have no responsibility to pay for medical treatment and related costs if my minor child is injured.
